

CATA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION CRITERIA

Dan Libera AT Scholarship - available to a student who has been accepted into a professional athletic training program in the state of Colorado

Jim Conboy AT Scholarship - available to a student who is currently enrolled in a professional athletic training program in the state of Colorado who has at least one year remaining in their program.

Application Deadline is **APRIL 1st.** Funds will be available for use during the upcoming school year.

A. Criteria:

- 1. Intent to pursue or proof of acceptance into athletic training education program in the state of Colorado
- 2. Cumulative GPA 3.2
- **3.** Perform with distinction in the following areas:
 - **a.** Academic program and institution. (i.e. club president, honors)
 - **b.** Athletic training duties/assignments
 - **c.** Academic coursework
 - **d.** Community service
- 4. Jim Conboy AT Scholarship applicants only: current NATA membership

B. The Application MUST Include:

- 1. CATA Scholarship Application Form
- **2.** One-page essay from the applicant on why they want to be an athletic trainer and their future goals in athletic training.
- 3. A Letter of Recommendation from a Certified Athletic Trainer
- **4.** A Letter of Recommendation from the Program Director or Clinical Education Coordinator (**Jim Conboy Only**)
- Committee Chair totals all of the ranked applications after review from the CATA HAA committee—applicant with the highest point total is the recipient of the

- scholarship.
- **D.** Committee Chair calls each recipient to notify them of the award and to congratulate them.
- **E.** Committee Chair confirms contact information.
- **F.** Committee chair notifies the Member at Large who is responsible for honors and awards, CATA President and CATA Treasurer of the selection
