

MEMBER AT LARGE

Term of Office

Per the CATA Bylaws, the term for Member at Large is two (2) years, beginning June 1, 2026, concluding May 31, 2028. Members may serve up to two (2) consecutive terms in the same office.

Eligibility Requirements

Candidates must:

- Be certified members of the NATA for at least five (5) years prior to nomination.
- Have resided and practiced professionally in Colorado for at least two (2) years prior to nomination.

Core Responsibilities (Per CATA Bylaws)

- Serve as a voting member of the Executive Board.
- Assist the Vice President with coordination of the Annual Meeting.

Position Overview

The CATA has two Members at Large who serve staggered terms to promote continuity on the Executive Board. Members at Large are expected to actively participate in all scheduled Board meetings and conference calls. Meetings are typically held monthly or quarterly, primarily via conference call, with one inperson annual meeting.

Each Member at Large serves as a liaison to specific CATA committees. This includes maintaining communication with committee chairs, collecting reports, and presenting updates during Executive Board meetings.
